

PREPARING FOR YOUR KYPHOPLASTY

ONCE YOU HAVE A SCHEDULED DATE FOR THE PROCEDURE, YOU WILL NEED TO PREPARE FOR THE PROCEDURE.

If your physician has ordered any laboratory tests, please ensure these are performed at least 4 days prior to the procedure to make sure the results are back in sufficient time.

A Vascular Institute nurse will call and speak with you prior to your procedure to instruct you on your home medication routine. Typically patients are instructed to:

- Continue to take blood pressure and seizure medications.
- Diabetic medication should be held the morning of appointment, however, please bring this medication with you to take during recovery.
- · Patients can bring insulin in to take during recovery.
- DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE.
- If you take Glucophage (Metformin), you will likely be asked to hold this after the procedure until your kidney function is checked. Typically this is done 48 hours after the procedure.
- Medications can be taken with a small sip of water.
- Must have a driver to/from appointment.
- Please bring food with you to eat during recovery time.
